Do you have a child with Angelman Syndrome (deletion positive) and a child without AS?

Participate in a study on gut function and diet through Purdue University

WHAT IS THE GOAL OF THIS STUDY?

The purpose of this study is to look at gut function in Angelman syndrome and its relationship to behaviors and diet. All study activities will be conducted from home.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Families with a child with Del+ AS and a full sibling without AS, 3-12 years old.




WHAT DOES PARTICIPATION INVOLVE?

Participation may include:

- (1) **Stool Collection**: Families will collect 3 stool samples from their child with AS and their child without AS. All materials and instructions will be provided.
- (2) Online Parent Surveys: Families will complete online surveys about their family's and children's characteristics.
- (3) **Phone Surveys**: Families will complete an initial phone interview about their child with AS's development and 3 brief phone calls about each of their children's diet.
